Katie and Linda sat with John Brier to learn how to update the website. Linda presented a letter to Town Administrator and the Selectman asking for a \$1500 budget which will be presented at the next town meeting.

New Business: We are thinking about participating in the 2022 Strawberry Festival. We would like to set up an informational booth and potentially give out seeds for pollinator gardens and flyers from either MDAR or UMASS Extension. Farmers Tim might also be interested in setting up near us for a mini farmers-market. Katie suggested that we might be able to get an observational hive from Worcester County Beekeeping, to be displayed. We could also have Local for Life pamphlets and maybe a giveaway.
